They were married in July 1993 and were blessed with two children, Danielle and Conner. Jennifer worked full time as a real estate agent, a job she excelled at, but she loved being a mom the most. Jennifer's love for children led them to become foster parents in 2004 and in 2007, adopted "Tootsie", an adorable two year old they had cared for since her birth. In June 2007, Gabe and Jennifer were unexpectedly blessed with the arrival of twin daughters, Ava and Isabella. Sadly, due to complications, Jennifer passed away after the birth of the twins.
