Student artists (*individual or group*) should depict one facet of the working beef industry through original art. 1st, 2nd & 3rd place payouts of \$100, \$75 & \$50 respectively. Winners will be posted on the Siskiyou County Cattlewomen Facebook Page, & school notification via mail. Winners will be recognized at the Siskiyou County Golden Fair and various 2024 Siskiyou County Cattlewomen events.

Theme: **The Working Beef Industry** Choose One to illustrate: Procurement (auction, private purchase), Production (cow calf, commercial, seedstock), Feeding (grazing, feedlot), Processing (Branding, Vaccination), Health (Vaccinations, Minerals, Worming, Fly Control), Transportation (Cattle Truck, Pickup & Trailer), Marketing (Advertising, Brand Awareness), Retailers (Local Butcher, Grocery Store, Restaurant, Private Sale), Products (Beef Cuts, By-Products).

Medium: Beadwork, Coloring (*K-1 only*), Diorama, Drawing, Ceramics, Jewelry, Leatherwork, Metalwork, Mixed Media, Modeling clay *must be hardened so that it does not melt in hot weather*, Painting on Canvas/Paper/Fabric/3D objects, Papier Mache, Pottery, Sculpture, Seed Work, Woodworking.

Dimensions: Hanging pieces **under 36"**

Tabletop pieces no larger than 12" x12" x 12"

Weight less than 50 lbs

Categories: Kindergarten – 5th grades

6th - 8th grades 9th - 12th grades

Judging: - Clearly depicts 1 chosen theme reflecting beef industry

- Skill level of the student artist


- Originality/Creativity of the student artist
